



Hopkins Avenue Resurfacing and Restoration

Project Details Take Shape

In coordination with FDOT, the city will soon be making improvements to Hopkins Avenue. Improvements will include road resurfacing from SR 50 to Grace Street, two 4' wide bike lanes, shared-lane markings, school zone signage, crosswalks, and Americans with Disability Act (ADA) compliant ramps and warning surfaces.

Public Works Director Kevin Cook states that currently the project is under final design review, and that invitations for companies to bid are expected to be sent out this spring.

Roadway construction is estimated to last from May 2018 - July 2018.
Sidewalk construction is estimated to last from July 2018 - August 2018.
Landscape construction is estimated to last from July 2018 - September 2018.
